ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 181 dated 12.11.2019, under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of no injury although it is alleged that shots were fired at the complainant. He also contends that the complainant had got the FIR lodged due to misunderstanding between the parties which has now been resolved. He has referred to the copy of the affidavit of the complainant at Annexure P2.

This Court, by the order dated 02.12.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 02.12.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
