The petitioner filed a writ petition alleging that there is illegal construction of shops etc., without approval from the Municipal Council and against the bye laws of the Municipal Council. The petition was disposed of on 3.7.2019 directing the Deputy Commissioner, Fatehgarh Sahib to consider and decide the representation dated 20.5.2019. It was further ordered that no demolition would be carried out during the pendency of the representation.

The grievance raised in the present petition is that needful has not been done.

Ms. Amrit Kaur Gill, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Fatehgarh Sahib, is present in Court. It is submitted that she has joined the office in October 2019, thereafter the matter was looked into and show cause notices issued for demolition. She seeks six weeks time so that the matter can be reconsidered and thereafter needful will be done as expeditiously as possible.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.
