AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The petitioner filed a writ petition raising grievance that some of the pensionary benefits have not been released to the petitioner. The writ petition was disposed of on 08.04.2019, directing the respondents to pass appropriate order within three months, on the representation dated 28.02.2019. It was further ordered that in case petitioner is found entitled for any monetary benefits, same be released to him within a period of three months thereafter.

The contempt petition is filed pleading that needful is not done by the respondent.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that order dated 26.08.2019 was passed and communicated to the petitioner.

He further submits that some of amount found due has been paid and balance would be paid within four weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that issue with regard to interest on the delayed payment is not dealt with.

The respondent shall make balance payment and would deal with the issue with regard to claim of the interest on the delayed payment within four weeks from today. If any amount is found due towards interest, same would be paid within four weeks thereafter.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

The petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedies, in accordance with law, for redressal of surviving grievance, if any.
