The petitioner herein, *inter alia*, prays for regularization of her services in the light of Punjab Adhoc, Contractual, Daily Wage, Temporary, Work charged and Outsourced Employees Welfare Act, 2016(for brevity, Welfare Act, 2016) notified on 24.12.2016(Annexure P-2).

It is the case of the petitioner that she was appointed as *Safai Sewak* on compassionate grounds on the contingency paid vacancy, vide order dated 11.01.2001(Annexure P-1) and working as such till date. Despite fulfilling the eligibility criteria of having continuous service for three years preceding the date of notification of Welfare Act, 2016, for regularizing the services of an employee, benefit thereof has not been extended to her. The legal notice dated 30.10.2017(Annexure P-5) served upon the respondents has also not been adverted to.

Given the nature of order being passed, no further proceedings or pleadings are required.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to pass a speaking order by

objectively considering the averments as made in the legal notice dated 30.10.2017(Annexure P-5) as also the contents of the instant writ petition by treating the same as supplementary representation, in accordance with law.

Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
