ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.02 dated 19.09.2019, under Sections 420, 419, 467 & 471 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Nuh, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he has prepared forged documents for the release of his truck. He, however, contends that the petitioner had contacted an agent who told him that on the petitioner paying fine of Rs.1 lakh, the necessary documents would be provided to him. The petitioner was not aware that the documents were forged. The petitioner is not involved in any other case. He is in custody for over 2 ½ months.

Learned State counsel states that although challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
