The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.273 dated 01.11.2019 registered under Sections 353, 186, 506, 323, 427, 34 IPC at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 29.11.2019, this petition was dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner Nos. 2 and 3.

The operative part of the order dated 29.11.2019, vide which petitioner Nos. 1, 4 and 5 have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioners has argued that the allegations of assaulting the complainant – Harjinder Singh are relating to petitioners No.2 and 3 namely Rashiv Goyal and Reetik Goel, therefore, he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition qua petitioners No.2 and 3. Ordered accordingly. Counsel for the petitioners on behalf of petitioners No.1, 4 and 5 has argued that petitioner No.1 is an old man aged about 76 years and there is no direct allegations against petitioners No.4 and 5. Notice of

motion for 18.12.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner Nos. 1, 4 and 5, in pursuance to the order dated 29.11.2019, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gandur Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that petitioner Nos. 1, 4 and 5 have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to petitioner Nos. 1, 4 and 5, vide order dated 29.11.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
