Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 83 dated 16.08.2019 registered under Sections 307, 379-B, 384 and 506 of IPC, 1860 and Section 27 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no injury case and the petitioner was arrested on 16.08.2019, since then he has been in custody and in other cases he has been acquitted. The challan has been presented in the present case.

On the instructions from ASI Angrej Singh, learned State counsel states that two other cases are pending against the petitioner in which he is on bail. In the present case, charges are yet to be framed.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Gurjeet Singh Brar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent, Central Prison, Faridkot, filed by the learned State counsel in the Court today, is taken on record. As per custody certificate the petitioner has undergone 3 months 14 days.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
