The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 416 dated 16.05.2019, under Sections 406, 420 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per bank statement (Annexure P-5), the account is in the exclusive name of the husband of the petitioner, namely Sharwan Kumar and the amount was transferred to his account.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner is in family terms and expecting in the first week of January, 2020. Reliance is placed upon medical certificate issued by the doctor in this regard.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sahab Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submitted that co-accused Sharwan Kumar, husband of the petitioner, has already been granted concession of regular bail.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It will be open for the Investigating Officer to call upon the petitioner to join investigation, if so required, by issuing a notice in this regard.
