This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.0785 dated 18.08.2018 registered under Section 6(c) of the Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Regulation and Prevention of Misuse) Act, 1994 and Section 120-B & 420 IPC at Police Station Model Town, District Panipat and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

A bare perusal of the FIR itself shows that there are direct allegations against the petitioner. Not only that; the specific currency notes, the serial numbers of which were already noted down by the raiding team, have been recovered from the petitioner. Hence, there are specific allegations supported by the documentary evidence.

In view of the above, it is not appropriate to interfere at this stage and to indulge in appreciation of the alleged evidence against the

petitioner. The actual facts and culpability of the petitioner in the crime, can be determined only through the trial.

Hence, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
