Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 98 dated 21.10.2017 registered under Sections 326, 325, 324, 323, 427, 34, 341, 148 and 149 of IPC, at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka, during the pendency of the trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury attributed is simple, rather father of the petitioner-Balvir Singh has also inflicted serious injuries by the complainant party and moreover Section 326 of IPC was added later on.

On the instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh, learned State counsel states that the investigation is going on and will take time to conclude.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Arvinder Pal Singh, Superintendent, Central Jail, Ferozepur, filed by the learned State counsel in the Court today, is taken on record. As per the custody certificate the petitioner has undergone 02 months 11 days.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
