The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.100 dated 05.06.2019 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 452, 307, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar.

The operative part of the order dated 02.12.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused Nishan Singh already stands arrested and there are no specific allegations against the petitioner. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajbir Singh, submits that as per the FIR, the petitioner has given an injury by kirpan on the arm of the complainant and he be directed to join the investigation. List again on 19.12.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 02.12.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI

Mukhtiar Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 02.12.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
