**SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)**

The grievance of the petitioner is that after directions were passed by this Court earlier on two occasions (19<sup>th</sup> August, 2013 and 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2015) vide the orders passed in **LPA No.1457 of 2013** and **CR No.3650 of 2015** (Annexures P-2 and P-3, respectively), the petitioner's application for partition was finally decided on 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2016 and Sanad Taqsim had also been duly issued on 22<sup>nd</sup> November, 2017, but the petitioner is not being put in possession of his share by way of executing the warrant of possession.

Considering the chequered history of the dispute and the strange approach of the State Authorities in dragging their feet for implementing their own order, the present revision is disposed off with a

direction upon the Ld. Financial Commissioner to decide the pending ROR No.660 of 2018 within three months from the date of communication of this order.
