Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.156 dated 12.9.2019 registered under Sections 326, 323, 324, 34 IPC at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural.

Prosecution case, as noticed by the learned Court of Sessions while dismissing pre-arrest bail application of the petitioner, is extracted as under:-

“The present case was registered at the instance of Sharanjit Kaur on the allegations that on 9.9.2019, she alongwith her father-in-law Nirmal Singh and brother-in-law Baljinder Singh was present at phirni and at about 8:30 pm, Mangat Singh armed with dang, Roshan Singh, Harpal Singh empty handed, Jagroop Singh empty handed came there. Harpal Singh raised a lalkara. Roshan Singh caught hold Nirmal Singh with both arms and Jagroop Singh

bited on middle finger of his right hand and some part of his finger was separated. Mangat Singh gave a dang blow to Nirmal Singh on his head. He fell down. She and Baljinder Singh came forward to rescue and all the accused attacked upon Baljinder Singh. They raised raula and all the accused fled away from the spot with their weapons.”

Learned State counsel has produced copy of Medico Legal Report containing opinion of the doctor which reads as under:-

“Injury No.1 which was kept under Xray observation is now declared as grievous in nature as Xray done shows that distal part phalynx of Middle finger of right hand missing.”

Learned counsel for the State has also brought to the notice of the Court that petitioner is a young man aged about 24 years whereas injured is around 50 years old. Hence, no ground to grant pre-arrest bail is made out.

Dismissed.
