Admittedly, elections to Panchayats of village Missarpura Wadda and Missarpura Chotta have already been held. Same have been notified and elected representatives are functioning at present. Only apprehension of the petitioners is that in the voter lists, on the basis of which instant election was held and wherein their names ought not to have figured, may remain alive for the next election as well. Mr. Doabia submits that these fears are unfounded. He submits that the same can be allayed in view of Section 24 of the Punjab State Election Commission Act, 1994, according to which a fresh voter-list has to be drawn before every election. He assures that grievance of the petitioners shall be looked into at the time, the next election is held.

In view of above, no cause of action survives in this petition. Same is hereby disposed of.
