The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.25 dated 13.03.2019 registered under Sections 420 and 406 IPC at Police Station Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur.

On 02.12.2019, the following order was passed:

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted regular bail and was facing the trial, however, on 19.10.2019, the petitioner filed an application for exemption and the trial Court dismissed the said application and has canceled the bail/surety bonds of the petitioner. Notice of motion for 19.12.2019. In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 07 days from today and the trial Court will release the petitioner on interim bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds and on payment of costs of Rs.2,000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Gurdaspur. The payment of costs shall be a pre-condition before accepting the bail/surety bonds of the petitioner.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 02.12.2019, has already appeared before the trial Court and he has been released on interim bail and he has also deposited the costs of Rs. 2,000/- as imposed by this Court.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order dated 02.12.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
