The instant writ petition has been filed by Ranjit Singh son of Sadhu Singh son of Rala Ram, a resident of Village Moga, District Jalandhar assailing the eviction order dated 04.10.2013 (**Annexure P-1**); and also memo dated 02.05.2018 (**Annexure P-2**), whereby the office of Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Bhogpur has intimated the petitioner that the officer concerned would be visiting the spot in question on 07.05.2018.
