Applicant – Nirmal Rani, estranged wife of Gagandeep Singh – respondent No.1, residing separately from him on account of matrimonial discord between the parties by way of filing the present application seeks transfer of divorce petition filed by the respondent No.1 against her having titled 'Gagandeep Singh Versus Nirmal Rani and another' pending before Principal Judge, Family Court Sirsa to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Muktsar Sahib.

I have heard learned counsel for the applicant besides going through the record.

A perusal of the divorce petition, transfer of which is being sought by the applicant, goes to show that there are serious allegations with regard to moral character of the applicant – wife Nirmal Rani, who

is respondent No.1 in the divorce petition. The person with whom, she has allegedly illicit relations namely Arshdeep Singh has been arrayed as respondent No.2 therein divorce petition. It is mentioned in the divorce petition that on 1.3.2018 petitioner – husband had received photograph of respondent No.1 – wife with respondent No.2 in compromising position on his mobile. He was shocked and convened Panchayat where family members of respondent – wife and other relations were present and father and brother of respondent – wife had executed an affidavit in that regard and took her along with them. Even thereafter, illicit relations between both the respondents continued.

Under the circumstances, I do not find it proper and appropriate to accept the application for transfer of the divorce petition.

The application is, therefore, dismissed.
