The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.162, dated 01.11.2019 registered at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga under Section 420 IPC. According to the contents of the FIR, the petitioner induced the complainant to part with money to get the complainant recruited in the Army. However, neither the money was returned nor he was got recruited.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated. In fact, two other persons were involved in the racket of recruitment and they had already been arrested by the police. The petitioner himself gave money to those persons for getting his son recruited and thus, the petitioner is aggrieved and cannot be said to be an accused.

3. There are precise allegations against the petitioner in the FIR and his defence that he is also an aggrieved person would be gone into by

the trial Court during the trial. At this stage, I see no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner as the allegation against him is serious in nature and the money allegedly paid is to be recovered.

4. The petition is accordingly dismissed.
