The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.294 dated 25.08.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 325, 452 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was alleged to be armed with a *lathi* but no specific injury is attributed to him. The allegations against the petitioner are general in nature and the offence for which Section 307 IPC has been invoked is attributed to co-accused, namely, Sardool Singh. He also contends that the petitioner, who is 20 years of age, is in custody for over three months and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Umesh Kumar, contends that although challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is 20 years of age, he is in custody for about three months, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
