This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of an appropriate writ, in the nature of mandamus directing respondents to provide an authoritative list of all pending FIRs/Cases in which the petitioner is said to be involved and to provide copies of all papers, documents, evidence etc. to the petitioner which he needs in order to be able to exercise his lawful right to legal defence in the appropriate Courts.
