Petitioner through the present petition assailed the correctness of second part of the order passed by the Court of Sessions directing the concerned SHO to impound the tractor and trolley.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that such order was passed without hearing the petitioner, who is owner of the vehicle and not named as an accused in the FIR.

This Court has heard learned counsel for the petitioner. In the considered view of this Court, it would be appropriate to direct the petitioner to file necessary application before the Court which had passed the impugned order and get decision thereon.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of by directing the petitioner to move appropriate application before the concerned Court. Learned Court would pass order in accordance with law within two months.
