Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.22 dated 27.02.2018 under Sections 420 & 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioners, following order was passed by this Court on 03.12.2019: -

“...Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that the dispute has been settled and the amount is paid to the complainant. It is further submitted that since the complainant has travelled abroad, he cannot procure his affidavit in this regard...”

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not

required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Paramjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 03.12.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
