On 02.12.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.92 dated 03.06.2019 registered under Sections 452, 427, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner along with certain other boys attacked at the residence of the first informant and damaged the vehicle-Bolero Pickup.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a delay of 6 days in filing the FIR and petitioner is sought to be falsely implicated. Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon an order dated 19.11.2019, passed in CRM-M-49089 of 2019.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. SPS Tinna, Addl. A.G.,Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 06.12.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-49089 of 2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Gurwinder Kaur, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 02.12.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
