The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.81 dated 02.11.2019, under Sections 326, 323, 324, 341 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Balachaur, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for petitioner No.2 contends that in the FIR it is alleged that petitioner No. 1 has given a blow with iron rod on the knee of the injured but there is no corresponding injury in the MLR of injured Major Singh. He also contends that petitioner No. 2 is attributed a simple injury which has been caused with a reverse side of 'dah' on the right shoulder of the injured.

The petition qua petitioner No. 1 was dismissed on 02.12.2019.

However, this Court, by the order dated 02.12.2019, had directed petitioner No.2 to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join

the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar, states that petitioner No.2 has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for petitioner No.2 and petitioner No.2 having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 02.12.2019 granting interim bail to petitioner No.2 is made absolute.

However, petitioner No.2 shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
