Short reply by way of counter affidavit of Anindita Mitra, Director, Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Department, Punjab is filed today in Court. The same is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner. As per the said reply, the matter was considered and rejected the claim of the petitioner by passing a speaking order dated 06.02.2019, which is placed on record as Annexure R-1.
