Heard learned counsel for the appellant and the respondent.

It appears from the records of this case that the learned counsel for the appellant as well as the appellant Surjit Kumar himself have agreed and undertaken before this Court that appellant will vacate the suit premises within a period of 6 months from 18.12.2018. On this limited issue notice of motion was issued upon the respondent.

Learned counsel for the respondent has appeared and submitted that the respondent also would be agreeable to the aforesaid offer and if 6 month's period be given to the appellant for vacating the premises, the respondent would have no objection.

Today also learned counsel for the appellant has repeatedly undertaken that. The appellant himself is present and he has also stated before this Court that he will vacate the premises within a period of 6 months commencing from 18.12.2018 which will come prior to 31.05.2019.

Accordingly, this appeal stands disposed of in view of the aforesaid

his undertaking before this Court to vacate the premises on or before 31.05.2019. This is made clear that this order is being passed on consent given by both the sides.

It is further made clear if appellant fails to vacate the premises within the time granted then the respondent would be at liberty to file a petition for revival of this appeal.
