MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.13 dated 08.01.2013 registered under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Sadar, Hansi.

On 19.12.2018 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that FIR No.13 dated 08.1.2013, under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Hansi, contains the allegations of embezzlement of amount by misusing 411 cheques of ICICI Lombard Insurance Company. It is submitted that none of the cheques were used to obtain any benefit by the petitioner. Notice of motion for 27.2.2019.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim

bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 19.12.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Kartar Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 19.12.2018, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
