This is a criminal writ petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in the married life of the petitioners at the behest of respondents No.4 and 5 and their relatives.

It is the case of the petitioners that they have performed inter-caste marriage and they have an apprehension of their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5. The photographs (Annexure P-2) have also been placed on record evidencing their marriage. They have submitted a representation dated 28.11.2019 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No. 2.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Rahul Mohan, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. A complete set of paper-book has been supplied to the learned State counsel.

At this stage, Mr. R.K.Arya, Advocate, has appeared on behalf

of respondents No.4 and 5 and filed his power of attorney. He states that respondents No.4 and 5 have accepted the marriage of the petitioners and there is no danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

In view of the above, the present petition has become infructuous.
