ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

This is second petition for grant of bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.6 dated 16.11.2018 registered under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and under Sections 482/483 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station S.S.O.C. SAS Nagar.

As per the case of the prosecution, 10 kg of opium was recovered from the conscious possession of petitioners along with the co-accused. The first bail application was dismissed as withdrawn on 16.07.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioners could not draw attention of the court to any change in the circumstances.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners particularly when recovery from the petitioners is of commercial quantity in view of bar under Section 37 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

However, keeping in view the facts that the petitioners are in custody, learned trial court is requested to make sincere endeavour to dispose of the case expeditiously.
