The petitioner filed a public interest litigation seeking direction to the respondent from stopping construction of dangerous interlock block roads in the remaining areas of Jind City and construct the cemented or metalled (Charocoal) roads.

The writ petition was disposed of on 22.7.2019 directing the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Jind, to look into the matter and pass a reasoned order on the representation dated 20.6.2019. The needful was to be done within eight weeks from the date of passing of the order.

The present petition has been filed pleading that the needful has not been done.

In the order proposed to be passed it will not be appropriate to delay the matter further by issuing a notice.

The contempt petition is disposed of with direction to the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Jind to take a decision on representation dated 20.6.2019 within two months from receipt of the certified copy of the order passed today. It is clarified that in case the needful is not

done as per the directions issued today, the petitioner shall be at liberty to file fresh contempt petition, however, one week advance notice would be served to the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Jind and in case the petitioner is forced to file fresh petition, the Municipal Council, Jind, shall remain present in Court on the said date.
