Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.59 dated 04.06.2019 registered under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (hereinafter to be referred as “the Act of 1985”), at Police Station Sector 49, Chandigarh.

As per case of the prosecution, the petitioner was found in conscious possession of 45 grams of opium when he was undergoing sentence in a previous concluded case, also under the Act of 1985.

Learned counsel for the Union Territory, submits that the petitioner was earlier also found in conscious possession of 17 grams of opium.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
