The petitioner, who is shown to be 84 years old, has filed this petition (through her attorney), seeking a direction that action be taken against respondents no.5 to 12.

In respect of her grievance, she is stated to have made a representation to the Additional Director General of Police (NRI Wing), Mohali (respondent no.2).

Though the petitioner, as per the memo of parties, has not given any address to show that she is a non-resident Indian, however; learned counsel appearing for her submits that the said application has been made to the ADGP, NRI Wing, Punjab, because she is residing in Canada.

Without making any comment on the aforesaid contention and in any case not on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the ADGP, NRI Wing, Punjab, Mohali, to hear the petitioner or

her attorney and to take action as may be warranted as per law, within a period of two months, from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If he comes to the conclusion that no action is called for, he would have an order passed, of a gazetted officer not below the rank of a Superintendent of Police, giving detailed reasons therein.
