The writ petition filed by the petitioner was disposed of on 18.3.2019 as the desired relief was granted to the petitioner. However, liberty was granted to the petitioner to make a representation within three months in case some grievance survives. It was further ordered that respondent No. 2 (in the writ petition) will consider the said representation.

The grievance raised in the present petition is that a representation was made but no decision has been taken till date.

It would be pertinent to note that there were no time-bound directions issued to the respondent for doing the needful, no case is made out for initiating contempt proceedings.

The contempt petition is disposed.

However, it is desired that the respondent-department shall take a decision on the representation filed by the petitioner within three months from the supply of certified copy of the order passed today.
