The petitioner filed CWP No. 14350 of 2019 raising a grievance that her late husband, who was working with the respondent-department was entitled to benefit of ex-gratia under the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Govt. Employees Rules, 2006. The writ petition was disposed of on 27.5.2019. The respondents (in the writ petition) were directed to decide the legal notice issued by the petitioner. The needful was to be done within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

There is nothing on record to show that earlier to issuance of legal notice dated 28.10.2019, certified copy of the order was supplied to the respondent.

In such circumstances, the contempt petition is disposed of directing the respondent to do the needful for compliance of the order dated 27.5.2019 within two months from the receipt of certified copy of the order passed today.
