Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to take legal action against respondents No.5 to 11. Prayer has also been made for issuance of direction to respondent No.5 to return all the educational documents of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner states that there is a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and respondent No.5 and it is for this reason, respondent No.5 has retained the documents of the petitioner with him. He restricts his prayer for a direction to the SSP, Mohali to consider his representation dated 18.10.2019 (Annexure P-1) for the limited purpose of return of all the certificates of the petitioner in possession of the respondent No.5.

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1 to 4 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sukhbeer Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Lest it may prejudice the interest of the parties, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar, District Mohali, to consider the prayer of the petitioner for return of her documents only allegedly in possession of respondent No.5 and to act in accordance with law.
