Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in an incident, which took place on 23.6.2019, the petitioners sustained injuries. They got themselves medically examined and MLRs were prepared. A complaint was made to the police, but no FIR has been registered. The complaint has been followed by a detailed representation dated 21.9.2019 (Annexure P1,) yet no steps have been taken.
