ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.187 dated 03.12.2015, under Sections 395, 308, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had been found innocent in investigation. She has been summoned to face trial as an additional accused under Section 319 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. He also contends that the petitioner is alleged to have given a blow with a baseball bat on the head of the complainant. This injury was found to be simple in nature. He also contends that the occurrence took place on the night intervening 02/03.12.2015. He further contends that the petitioner is 42 year old lady and is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 04.12.2019, had directed petitioner to appear before the trial Court and in the event of her doing so, she was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 09.12.2019 and has been released on interim bail in terms of the order dated 04.12.2019.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for petitioner, the order dated 04.12.2019 granting interim bail to petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
