[1] Learned counsel contends that the petitioners fulfill the conditions stipulated in instructions, Annexure P-1 dated 29.07.2011 entitling them to regularization but no orders have been passed in respect thereto despite legal notice, Annexure P-3 dated 01.10.2019. Learned counsel states that the petitioners would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice, Annexure P-3 dated 01.10.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

legal notice, Annexure P-3 dated 01.10.2019 in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
