Learned counsel states that the legal notice Annexure P-8 dated 27.10.2019 has been served upon the respondents in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the instant writ petition but the same has not been decided till date and that the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing the respondents to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice Annexure P-8 dated 27.10.2019.

Notice of motion.

Learned Sr. DAG, Haryana, states that the legal notice has been served only recently and the petitioner has rushed to Court without waiting for the decision on the same and that in the circumstances, the writ petition is premature and may be disposed of as such.

Admittedly, legal notice Annexure P-8 dated 27.10.019 has been issued only recently. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of at this stage to await the outcome of the decision on the legal notice by the competent Authority while making it clear that in case the circumstances of the case, so

warrants, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek redress by approaching the court of law.
