Today, at the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the points raised herein before the trial Court including the submission to the effect that the FIR came to be lodged under some mistaken belief and that the misunderstandings have now been resolved.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

Since the challan has already been presented and the matter has been pending before the Trial Court since the last more than one year for

recording prosecution evidence, the Trial Court is thus directed to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from today.
