The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 606 dated 22.10.2018, under Sections 406, 420, 506, 120-B read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Sections 4, 5 and 6 of the PCMCS Act, 1978, registered at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in the process of returning the money to the investors and, therefore, he may be protected from arrest.

Heard.

This is the second petition for anticipatory bail preferred by the petitioner. The first petition bearing CRM-M No. 21889 of 2019 was dismissed by this Court on 01.10.2019. The allegations against the petitioner are that the Company wherein the petitioner was a promoter had taken money from several investors and had not returned the same. There is no material to suggest that the petitioner has returned the money to the investors,

therefore, I cannot take another view in the matter at this stage.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
