In pursuance of order dated 02.12.2019, Status Report dated 04.12.2019 by way of affidavit of Sandeep Goel, PPS, SSP Ludhiana (Rural) on behalf of the State has been filed today in Court which is taken on record. It is specifically stated in the status report that an FIR No.109 dated 02.11.2019, was registered under Sections 457, 380, 427 IPC at Police Station Sudhar against some unidentified persons with regard to theft of ATM machine. Thereafter, investigations were made and on 20.11.2019, the Investigating Officer arrested the accused Amandeep Singh @ Sonu @ Pinna R/o Basti Nizamudin, Malwal Wala Road, Ferozepur. It has been further stated that the said Amandeep Singh @ Sonu @ Pinna is the husband of the applicant – petitioner. On 21.11.2019, the said Amandeep Singh @ Sonu @ Pinna was produced before the learned Illaqa Magistrate, Jagraon and on the request of the Investigating Officer, learned Illaqa Magistrate, Jagraon granted five days police remand of Amandeep Singh @ Sonu @ Pinna. It has also been further stated that Police never arrested the accused Amandeep Singh @ Sonu @ Pinna on 15.11.2019. The

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said accused is a habitual offender and six other cases are pending against him.

After hearing learned State counsel, it is apparent that the husband of the applicant – petitioner is in judicial custody in pursuance of the FIR which was lodged on 02.11.2019 and therefore, no further proceedings are required in the present case.
