This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3(1)(C) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2007 for extension of parole for another six weeks, granted vide order dated 17.10.2019 by this Court

Reply has been filed by the State in the Court today. The same is taken on record. As per the reply, the petitioner was convicted and sentenced for fifteen years in case FIR No.151 dated 8.9.2011 registered under Sections 15, 17, 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Ding, Sirsa

Learned State counsel submits that as per the report dated 7.12.2019 (Annexure R-1) sent by SHO PS Sramgarh, Sethan, District Sikar addressed to Superintendent, District Jail, Sirsa, the wife of the petitioner is suffering from disease and her surgery is scheduled to be done on 17.12.2019. There is nobody in the family to look after her wife.

Learned State counsel has also placed on record a communication received from Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Sirsa, which is taken on record as Mark 'A'. He further concedes that he did not misuse the concession of parole earlier granted to him in the year 2018.

Heard.

This is to be noticed that the petitioner has not misused the concession of parole earlier granted to him. The operation of the wife of the petitioner is scheduled to be done on 17.12.2019 and there is nobody in the family to look after her.

In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed and parole already granted to the petitioner is extended for another four weeks from today on his furnishing surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Duty Magistrate. The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities on the date and time to be noticed by the releasing Court/ Duty Magistrate.
