1. Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider and promote the petitioner as Forest Ranger from the date his junior i.e. respondent No.4 was promoted as Forest Ranger under the SC category.

2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has served legal notice Annexure P/5 dated 03.07.2019 in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the writ petition but the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim as made in legal notice Annexure P/5 dated 03.07.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Without commenting on the merits of the claim or entitlement of the petitioner for promotion, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim as made in legal notice Annexure P/5 dated 03.07.2019, in accordance with law, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
