By way of present petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider his claim for grant of pensionary benefits by taking his entire service including service rendered against an Aided post as well as till his retirement and consequently pay entire arrears along with 18% compound interest thereon. The petitioner also caused legal notice dated 16.08.2019 (Annexure P-4), but the same has not been adverted to by the respondents. Hence the petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of petition, Ms. Monica Chhibber Sharma, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent-State.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 16.08.2019 (Annexure P-4) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
