Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case No. NDPS-312-2015, FIR No. 169 dated 16.11.2014 registered under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the present case, challan has been presented on 26.10.2015 and the petitioner has been appearing before the trial Court on every date, but on 21.09.2019 due to misunderstanding, he could not appear before the trial Court and non-bailable warrants were issued against him.

On the instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, learned State counsel states that challan has already been presented on 26.10.2015.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and the trial Court is directed to admit the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Petitioner is directed to deposit an amount of Rs. 10,000/- towards payment of fine with the District Legal Services Authority, Moga.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
