Grievance of the petitioner herein is against the transfer order dated 27.11.2019 (Annexure P-2), whereby he has been transferred from the office of Civil Surgeon, Tarn Taran to P.H.C, Nauashehre Majja Singh, District Gurdaspur.

2. Contents of the writ petition have been perused.
3. Transfer being matter of administrative exigencies, this Court generally interferes, if at all, very cautiously. Transfer is not a punishment but an essential aspect of service, particularly, on a transferable post.
4. In my opinion, the impugned transfer order dated 27.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) does not call for any interference by this Court in exercise of its extraordinary writ jurisdiction vested under Article 226 of Constitution of India.

Petition is, accordingly, dismissed being devoid of any merit.
