Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.0307 dated 21.09.2019, under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 341, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 325, IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on the previous date of hearing i.e. 05.12.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner relies on order dated 31.10.2019 passed in CRM-M-46281 of 2019 vide which this Court while issuing notice for 13.12.2019 stayed the arrest of co-accused of the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 13.12.2019.

To come up along with CRM-M-46281 of 2019.

Interim order in the same terms ”

Contentends that in terms of the above order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from H.C. Sukhchain, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 05.12.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required. Also stated that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner.

In view of above, interim order dated 05.12.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is also made clear that petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

Disposed off accordingly.
