The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.31 dated 15.03.2019, under Sections 379-B, 411, 392 and 482 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Division No.4, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR was registered on the basis of secret information that the petitioner and others had formed gang for looting and robbing the passersby. The petitioner is in custody for over nine months. He also contends that the co-accused namely Sarandeep Singh @ Sunny Boxer has been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-30116-2019 on 16.10.2019.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Swaran Singh states that although charges have been framed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over nine months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
