The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.93, dated 17.09.2019 registered at Police Station Rori, District Sirsa, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985.

2. The petitioner has been named as an accused on the disclosure statement of co-accused Biru Ram s/o Bhura Ram. He had stated that the heroin found in his possession had been purchased from the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated. The main accused Biru Ram s/o Bhura Ram has been granted bail by the trial Court. Regarding other two cases pending against the petitioner, in one he has undergone the sentence and in other he is on bail. Thus, the petitioner be granted anticipatory bail.

4. The petitioner is alleged to be the supplier of heroin. Distribution of hard drugs is a very serious matter and needs to be

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thoroughly investigated. Just because the petitioner has already undergone his sentence in another case under the NDPS Act, 1985 and is on bail in one other case, it cannot be said that he deserves the concession of anticipatory bail in this case. In fact, these circumstances would go against him as despite having been convicted once, the petitioner has not reformed himself.

5. The petition is without any merit and is accordingly dismissed.
